- **Stamp Set:** Sending Cheer
- **Cardstock:** Basic White Thick
- **Stampin' Pads:** Memento Black, Pecan Pie, Mossy Meadow, Cherry Cobbler, Craft White
- **Misc:** Traditions of St. Nick Designer Series Paper (DSP), Sending Cheer Dies, Classic Matte Dots, Multipurpose Adhesive, Stampin' Dimensionals, Scissors

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

**Basic White:** 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"

**DSP** (top layer): 3" x 4"

**DSP** (bottom layer): 2-1/4" x 4"

**Basic White** (image layer): 3-1/2" x 2-1/2"

**Basic White** (scrap)

**DSP** (scrap)

## CARD TUTORIAL

- Cut, score and fold the Basic White card base.
- Adhere the DSP to the bottom of the card base, leaving approximately 1/8" around the right, left and bottom edges. Then, adhere the DSP to the top of the card front.
- Use Mossy Meadow to stamp the sentiment on the bottom portion of the sentiment layer.
- On Basic White scrap, stamp the gingerbread man in Pecan Pie. Stamp the face using White Craft Stampin' Ink. Then, use Cherry Cobbler and Mossy Meadow to stamp the holly leaves and berries.
- Use the Sending Cheer Dies to die cut the stamped gingerbread man, holly leaves, berries and a set of heart buttons from DSP scrap. Use scissors to trim off the ornament loop from the gingerbread person.
- Adhere the heart buttons to the gingerbread man. Then, adhere the gingerbread man to the image layer using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Center and adhere the image layer to card front.
- Embellish with die cut Holly leaves and berries and the Classic Matte Dots.
