- **Stamp Set:** Inspirational Sketches, Notes of Nature
- **Cardstock:** Basic White Thick
- **Stampin' Pads:** Early Espresso, Pecan Pie, Garden Green, Boho Blue, Copper Clay, Crumb Cake
- **Misc:** Paper Shopping Bag (kraft colored), Blender Pens, Neutrals Adhesive-Backed Sequins, Paper Snips, Stampin' Dimensionals, Adhesive of Choice

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic White (card base): 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", score at 4-1/4"

Kraft Paper (background layer): 5" x 3-3/4"

Basic White (image layer): 3" x 2-1/4"

Basic White (scrap)

CARD TUTORIAL

- Cut, score, and fold the Basic White card base.
- To create the background on the kraft paper, stamp the following images from Notes of Nature:
 - "Field Notes" - Pecan Pie
 - Leaves - Garden Green
 - Dried Flowers - Boho Blue
 - Speckles - Early Espresso
 - Grid - Early Espresso, stamped off for a lighter shade
- Center and adhere the stamped kraft background to the card front.
- Use Early Espresso to stamp the bird on Basic White scrap paper.
- Color the stamped bird using a Blender Pen and the following stamp pads: Crumb Cake, Copper Clay, Pecan Pie, and Early Espresso. Use the Blender Pen and lightly tap the ink pad of the selected color to pick up the ink.

TIP: Before applying color to the image, test the "inked-up" Blender Pen on scrap paper, to ensure the desired color.

- Use scissors to cut out the bird. Then, use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere to the image layer.
- Center and adhere the image layer to the card front.
- Embellish with Neutrals Adhesive-Backed Sequins.
- For a matching envelope, re-create the background on a 6" x 2-1/2" piece of kraft paper. Then, adhere to the envelope flap and trim excess.
