- **Stamp Set:** Inspirational Sketches, Notes of Nature
- **Cardstock:** Basic White Thick
- **Stampin' Pads:** Early Espresso, Pecan Pie, Garden Green, Boho Blue, Crumb Cake
- **Misc:** Paper Shopping Bag (kraft colored), Neutrals Adhesive-Backed Sequins, Rustic Metallic Dots, Paper Snips, Stampin' Dimensionals, Adhesive of Choice

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

**Basic White** (card base): 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", score at 4-1/4"

**Kraft Paper** (background layer): 5-1/4" x 4"

**Kraft Paper** (strip): 5-1/4" x 3/4"

**Kraft Paper** (stamped strip): 5-1/4" x 1/2"

**Basic White** (layer): 3-3/4" x 3"

**Basic White** (image layer): 3-1/2" x 2-3/4"

**Basic White & Kraft Paper** (scrap)



## CARD TUTORIAL:

- Cut, score, and fold the Basic White card base.
- To create the background on the kraft paper, stamp the following images from Notes of Nature:
  - Grid and Sentiment - Crumb Cake
  - Speckles - Early Espresso stamped directly on the paper, and also "stamped-off".
- Once stamped, center and adhere the stamped background to the card front.
- Starting at the top, use Early Espresso to stamp the "Field Notes" image down the kraft strip.
- Adhere the stamped kraft strip down the center of the unstamped kraft strip.
- Adhere the layered strips along the left edge of the stamped background on the card front.
- Use Early Espresso to stamp the flower image and sentiment on the Basic White image layer.
- On scraps of Basic White and kraft paper, stamp the flower image. Use scissors to cut out select flowers or leaves. Then, adhere over the stamped flower on the image layer, as pictured.
- Center and adhere the image layer and Basic White layer to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Embellish with Neutrals Adhesive-Backed Sequins and Rustic Metallic Dots.
- For a matching envelope, stamp the flower image in Early Espresso on the envelope flap.
