## SUPPLY LIST

- **Stamp Set:** Inspirational Sketches, Notes of Nature
- **Cardstock:** Basic White Thick
- **Stampin' Pads:** Early Espresso, Copper Clay, Crumb Cake, Pecan Pie
- **Misc:** Paper Shopping Bag (kraft colored), Exposed Brick 3D Embossing Folder, Blender Pens, Neutrals Adhesive-Backed Sequins, Stampin' Dimensionals, Adhesive of Choice

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

**Basic White** (card base): 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", score at 4-1/4"

**Kraft Paper** (embossed layer): 5-1/4" x 4"

**Basic White** (image layer): 4" x 2-3/4"

## CARD TUTORIAL

- Cut, score, and fold the Basic White card base.
- With the embossing folder open, use the Pecan Pie stamp pad to apply ink to one half of the embossing folder. Only apply ink on the raised side (with the Stampin' Up! ® logo), by lightly tapping the stamp pad directly on the embossing folder. Then, place the kraft paper inside the embossing folder and emboss.
- Use Early Espresso to stamp the speckles on the embossed kraft paper.
- Center and adhere the embossed kraft layer to the card front.
- Use Early Espresso to stamp the mushrooms on the Basic White image layer.
- Color the stamped image using a Blender Pen and the following stamp pads: Crumb Cake, Copper Clay, Pecan Pie, and Early Espresso. Use the Blender Pen and lightly tap the ink pad of the selected color to pick up the ink.

**TIP: Before applying color to the image, test the "inked-up" Blender Pen on scrap paper, to ensure the desired color.**

- Use Copper Clay to stamp the sentiment on the image layer, beneath the mushrooms.
- Center and adhere the image layer to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Embellish with Neutrals Adhesive-Backed Sequins.
- For a matching envelope, re-create the background on a 6" x 2-1/2" piece of kraft paper. Then, adhere to the envelope flap and trim excess.
