- Stamp Set: Latte Love
- Cardstock: Basic White Thick, Early Espresso, Pecan Pie
- Stampin' Pads: Early Espresso, Pecan Pie
- Stampin' Blends: Moody Mauve, Lost Lagoon
- **Misc:** Latte Love Dies, Linen Thread, Adhesive– Backed Swirl Dots, A Little Latte Designer Series Paper (DSP), Stampin' Dimensionals, Adhesive of Choice

## **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Basic White** (card base):  $5-1/2'' \times 8-1/2''$ ,

score at 4-1/4"

Early Espresso (strip): 5-1/2" x 3/4"

**Pecan Pie** (layer): 5-1/2" x 1-3/4"

Basic White (layer): 4" x 3"

**Basic White** (image layer): 3-3/4" x 2-3/4"

**Basic White** (scrap)

## CARD TUTORIAL

- Cut, score, and fold the Basic White card base.
- Use Pecan Pie ink to stamp the coffee design on the Pecan Pie layer.
- Use Early Espresso to stamp the coffee beans on the Early Espresso strip.
- Adhere the Pecan Pie layer to the bottom of the card front. Then, adhere the Early Espresso strip to the card front, keeping the bottom edge flush against the top of the Pecan Pie layer.
- On the Basic White image layer, stamp the sentiment in Early Espresso.
- On Basic White scrap, stamp two coffee mugs and a spoon using Early Espresso ink. Then, use Pecan Pie ink to stamp a sentiment and stamp the coffee inside the mugs.
- Color the coffee mugs using Stampin' Blends. Then, use dies to cut out the mugs and spoon.
- Adhere the mugs and spoon to the Basic White image layer as pictured.
- Use scissors to cut out the sentiment and cut a banner edge. Poke a small hole in the other end and use linen thread to tie the sentiment to the mug handle with a decorative bow.
- Center and adhere the image layer to the Basic White layer using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Center and adhere the layered image to the card front.
- Embellish with Adhesive-Backed Swirl Dots.
- For a matching envelope, adhere a  $6'' \times 2-1/2''$  piece of DSP to the flap and trim excess DSP.
